The school district's primary source is **WeatherBug.** This weather station sits on top of Wooster High School and provides the most accurate weather information for Wooster, Ohio.



When Should I Stay Home?



I am ready to go back to school when I am...

Fever free without the assistance of medication for 24 hours (i.e., Tylenol, Motrin, Advil).	Free from diarrhea for 24 hours.	Free from rash or fever and have been evaluated by my medical provider if needed.	Evaluated by my medical provider if needed.	Free from drainage and/or have been evaluated by my medical provider if needed.	Released by my medical provider to return to school.	Consider COVID test. Consult with my medical provider before returning to school.

If your child has strep throat or another bacterial infection, he/she should stay home until the antibiotic has been given for at least 24 hours and your health care provider has given permission for your child to return to school. We encourage you to seek medical attention when your child is sick and to follow your health care provider's recommendations about returning to school and other activities.

ENROLLMENT TIMELINE CHANGES 2024-2025



- Intra-district Open Enrollment: Allows families living within the Wooster City School District to request that their child attend a different elementary school within the district instead of the school assigned based on their residence.
- Inter-district Open Enrollment: Allows students living outside the Wooster City School District to apply for enrollment within Wooster City Schools.
