School Absences/Tardy


The parent or guardian must provide an excuse for each absence to the school. Parents or guardians should call the school (330-262-3821) the morning of each absence. If the school does not receive any communication for the absence, it will be recorded as unexcused. We have voicemail to accept calls before and after school. You may leave a message about absences. Just a reminder that our attendance policy allows for a maximum of five approved vacation days per year, requested at least two weeks in advance. For more information on school. School starts at 9:05 am, a student is considered tardy if they arrive after this time.

Arrival and Dismissal

Safety is always a #1 concern. Thank you for partnering with us by using the crosswalk in and out of the parking lot, turning right onto Oak Hill as you exit the parking lot in the afternoon, and remaining in your car if you are in the pick-up lane. Please also refrain from using your cell phone during arrival and dismissal. Students may only enter from the passenger side of the car in the pickup lane and may not enter a car until the cars have come to a complete stop. Because we have such a large population of small, young children, we are asking parents to wait by the walking path and keep the entrance clear so that the children and teachers can see everyone. Thank you so much for helping us keep the children safe.

Please do not park or drop off on Parkview St. It is reserved for busses. Violators may be ticketed or towed.

- 5. When you exit the parking lot, please make a right-hand turn onto Oak Hill


Please stay at your designated sign until the car in front of you moves.
