As we continue into the new school year, we would like to give a few reminders to families about dismissal. If a student has a change in their normal transportation routine, please send a note to their teacher or call the school office before 3 PM.

If your child is being dismissed as a walker please do not park your vehicle in the preschool parking lot or on nearby streets to pick up your student. Students dismissed from the west entrance on Bowman St. should be walking home. If you are picking up your student by car, please use the car loop off of Quinby. Using the correct door for dismissal helps us do our part to keep traffic moving.

When picking up your student in the car loop, please have your tag hanging from your rearview mirror. If someone else is picking up your student that day, they should also use that tag. If you don't have a tag and need one, send a note to your student's teacher, and they will send home the necessary paperwork to receive a tag. If you need an **additional** tag, please send a note with your current tag number listed, and an additional tag will be provided, Thank you for partnering with us to keep students safe at dismissal!
