## About the Program

The College of Wooster Department of Education in partnership with Wooster City Schools has developed a free online tutoring program to support local students, teachers, and parents. This program will be staffed by C.O.W. student volunteers and be delivered through Microsoft Teams. Tutors can be scheduled Monday through Friday from 9:00 am until 4:00 pm.

## How will the tutoring program work?

Wooster City Schools students, teachers, or parents will use an online booking system to schedule a 30-minute session with an online tutor. Tutors are from a range of majors and minors across campus. Once booked, the WCS student and the COW tutor will receive an email that has a link to the scheduled session that they both will use at the appointed time.
