# Cornerstone Elementary School Walker Procedures

Student safety during dismissal is our first priority. Please read through the following dismissal procedures for walkers. To help us prioritize student safety, we will need a parent/guardian to complete the informational form attached and return to school as soon as possible. In our efforts to keep your child/children safe, it is imperative that we have correct information on file.

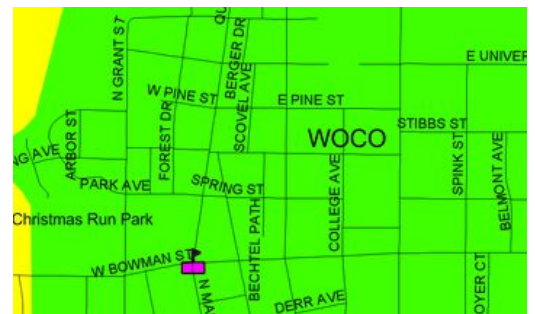
## Door #2 Walkers (Main Front Doors)

If your child/children live south of Cornerstone Elementary School, they will be exiting through door #2 (front main doors) for dismissal.



## Door #7 Walkers (Across from Playground)

If your child/children live north of Cornerstone Elementary School, they will be exiting through door #7 (located across from the playground) for dismissal. Students will either turn left to access Grant Street or turn right to utilize the walking path, which will lead students to their homes north of Cornerstone (for example, a child walking home who lives on Forest Drive will exit through door #7).



## Crossing Guard Locations

Beall Avenue

Walker procedures ensure that students will not be crossing near the drive where cars are exiting. Please discuss with your child/children which door they will be utilizing for dismissal. ## Car Rider Procedures

Student safety during dismissal is our first priority. Please read through the following dismissal procedures for car riders. To help us prioritize student safety, we will need a parent/guardian to complete the informational form attached and return to school as soon as possible. In our efforts to keep your child/children safe, it is imperative that we have correct information on file.

### *Afternoon Dismissal*

To ensure the safety of all students, each car rider will be given an assigned number. Each family will be given 2 copies of their pickup number. This will be our identification to match students with the correct car/pick up person. These numbers are to be used by any car that is picking up your child/children. If you need additional numbers, please contact Mrs. Richard and she will be sure to get them to you.

Please make sure whomever is picking up your child/children has this card hung from the rearview mirror for quick recognition. We understand that emergencies arise. If possible please send a note or call the office to clarify change in transportation.

If your child uses a car seat/booster seat, please have it placed on the passenger side to make entry into the vehicle safe.

We hope that our procedures will continue to make pickup a smooth transition. Our main goal is the safety of our students. We thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation, and please understand that when we check for clarification with the office as to who is to pick up a student, it is for their safety. We appreciate your partnership as we put the safety of our children first.
