May 16, Friday: Breakfast / Graduation Practice

9:30am – 10:30am - Graduation Practice - gault This is a <u>mandatory practice</u> for all who plan to walk with the class at the graduation ceremony. (Those that are taking an AP test will be excused). Names will be marked on chairs alphabetically. Find your name & sit down in order for us to begin. Graduation tickets for inclement weather will be dispersed after practice. Tickets are evenly split between graduates. It appears at this time that each student will receive 6 tickets.

May 18, Sunday at 1:00pm Follis Field (weather permitting) Check the district website should the weather become questionable. We will post any changes there. Graduates need to <u>report to the Gault at noon, fully dressed and ready to go for graduation</u>. Your names will again be labeled on the chairs.
